OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE

The UK College of Medicine's official method of correspondence with students is via the UK assigned email address. I understand that I am responsible for accessing my UK assigned email account at least weekly and preferably daily, and for taking any required action indicated in official university correspondence sent to this address. I also understand that it is my responsibility to delete old message from my email inbox so that it will not become full, and that I am responsible for any consequences resulting from undeliverable messages due to an over-limit inbox.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

I understand that my enrollment in the College of Medicine and registration into courses constitutes a contractual financial obligation to pay tuition and fees for which I am liable. I am responsible for reading and understanding the current Drop/Refund policy of the University as it appears in the current Schedule of Classes Academic Calendar. Permission to cancel enrollment does not constitute, nor shall it be construed as, a waiver by UK of my financial obligation. I understand that any financial assistance I receive will be applied against my billed charges to reduce my financial obligation.

I am responsible for all outstanding debts and contracts with the University. The University reserves the right to assess financial penalties (including collection costs) on any indebtedness. Any past-due accounts may be referred to an outside collection agency which could result in such collection costs.

It is the responsibility of each student to maintain a current local mailing address and a current phone number in the MyUK system at all times.

Student Privacy Law

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974, as amended, is a federal law that protects the privacy and confidentiality of personally identifiable information contained within student education records. The University of Kentucky complies with FERPA confidentiality protections and adheres to procedures dealing with student **education records** and directory information recommended by the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers. This law applies to K-12 as well as postsecondary education and is commonly known as the *Buckley Amendment*.
