FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many evening seminars do I need to complete for the course?

You are required to attend two seminars per year for a total of four. If you are joining as an M2 student you will have the same requirement. Three to four seminars will be offered per semester, so you should aim to attend one per semester to complete the requirement.

When will the schedule of seminars be announced?

Announcements will be made via Blackboard about 1 month prior to the event.

How do I receive credit for attending the Introduction to Global Health Seminars?

In order to receive credit you must submit questions from the reading material as assigned, participate actively in the discussion and complete your information on the sign-in sheet at the event. If for some reason you were in attendance and did not sign the sheet, please contact the administrative staff to let us know immediately in order to receive credit.

Once I complete a module/quiz do I need to submit anything to receive credit?

The modules and quizzes will have you submit your completion certificate to blackboard or a screen shot of your proof of completion. Follow the directions on Blackboard.

What is the time commitment for the Intro to GH course?

The course will vary in length for each student, but the approximate time commitment will be between 25-35 hours. This includes the course modules, readings, and required evening seminars. This course can be completed over your first and second year.

Can I do the Intro to GH course elective in my second year?

It is recommended you begin the elective in your first year due to the availability of spots in the discussion groups. You will also need ample time to complete the online modules. If you enroll in the course, then decide you will not want to complete it, you can drop with no penalty.
